Dress Code 2021-2022

In addition to the Dress and Grooming Policy of the CFBISD Student Code of Conduct, students at the Bea Salazar Learning Center are required to be in Salazar dress code starting their first day of enrollment. Please prepare for the dress code as follows:

Shirts

Solid white, black, or gray button-up, polo, or crew neck tee shirt. All shirts/blouses must have sleeves. No logos larger than 2 inches. Undergarments may not be visible through the shirt. One plain white shirt may be worn under the uniform shirt. Shirts are to fit properly, remain tucked in at all times, and be worn as intended.



Pants

Black or Khaki-colored pants/shorts with belt loops must be worn with a belt and <u>must fit</u> <u>properly</u>: Joggers (khaki-color, drawstring-style) are allowed. Pants may not sag in the rear. Pants may not be rolled or cuffed. No athletic shorts or tights may be worn under the required pants or shorts. Cargo pants or shorts (those with numerous pockets on the legs) are not allowed.

Socks

Solid white, gray or black: any length; no logos larger than 2 inches.



Shoes

Students will wear **ATHLETIC/GYM SHOES** only (rubber-soled, aka *tennis shoes*).

Belts

Solid black, brown, khaki, gray or white belts must be worn at all times <u>if pants/shorts have belt loops</u>.



Optional Sweatshirt/Sweaters

Sweaters or sweatshirts worn inside the building must be solid white, black, or gray only. Hoodies may <u>not</u> be worn inside the building. No pockets are allowed on the sweaters or sweatshirts. Outerwear, including (*but not limited to*) coats, hats, caps, and gloves must be left at the front door.

Miscellaneous

- No logos larger than 2 inches may be visible on any item of clothing.
- Jewelry will not be worn.
- Tattoos may not create a distraction to the learning environment.
- All items worn in hair (elastics, bobbi pins, etc.) should be solid white, black, gray, or brown.
- Hair style and color must comply with the CFBISD Code of Conduct.
- Bags, backpacks, wallets and purses are not allowed on campus.

Principal is the Final Authority:

The Board delegates to the principal the authority to make final determinations as to whether clothing or grooming is or is not within this policy. The ruling of the building principal regarding compliance or non-compliance with the Dress & Grooming Policy and corresponding consequences assigned for violation of this policy is final, and may not be appealed to the Superintendent, his/her designee, or the Board.
